














CEDARS PARK ART PROJECT

Message from Dave Muller, Chair CIC Board

First of all a big thank you to everyone who took part in our recent on-line survey. The CIC Board have listened to what you have said and have so far taken the following action: -

You said the Centre was looking tired

The Board agree and have arranged for not just the Hillyer Hall, Ash & Beech rooms but the corridors to be repainted. This work will be undertaken during the next couple of months and we will ensure our hirer's are not inconvenienced wherever possible.

You had concerns about cleanliness of the centre

I have arranged for our cleaners to increase the amount of times they clean the centre from twice to four times per week. I am also arranging for our cleaners to deep clean all the floors throughout the centre and once the building work on our extension is completed and the preschool can move their equipment into the new store, I will arrange for the 2 changing rooms to be deep cleaned also.

You asked for some play equipment

We have moved the fence back to the front entrance of the centre, so we have some more space for play

equipment on the grassed area next to the Aviary patio area. I have met with the Operations and Maintenance Manager from Stowmarket Town Council (his team are responsible for play areas in the town), who has advised me all play equipment has to be checked every week to comply with current Health & Safety regulations. The CIC Board have agreed to pay for Peter from the Aviary to attend the training course run by RoSPA and once this has been completed we will be looking to install some play equipment. The CIC Board would like local residents to help choose the play equipment and once we have a few ideas we will hold an open day where residents can come in and see the items we are considering and vote for the equipment they would like us to install

You were concerned about the litter around the site

Litter is a big problem wherever you go, but thanks to members of the Cedars Park Residents Association, myself and some local residents we undertook a litter pick on 11th May and filled about 10 bags, not just around the community centre but across the estate also. During the Whitsun half term week, 2 children from the holiday club, along with the pre-school manager, also undertook another litter pick around the centre car park. There are bins both inside and outside the centre

Chernobyl Childrens Lifeline & Charity Shop

As the date of the group arrival approaches we would like to say a very big thank you to all of our supporters who have helped to make this years visit possible. 15 children arrive on July 1st and four of them will have their birthdays while they are here, the first being on the day of arrival!

Many people have dropped donations into our Charity shop but not left their details so I have been unable to write personally to thank you. If you prefer to remain anonymous then of course we respect this but I would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge how grateful we are for your contributions.

The Charity Shop provides a great focal point for us and helps to raise awareness for our work. Although we have Links across the country we are not a National chain of shops, all staff are all unpaid volunteers. We really do need people who are able to offer a few hours a week to help out covering for holidays and sickness, each session is only 3 hours so if you think you could be available to help with "spot cover" we would love to hear from you, no experience is necessary and you're never on your own. Everyone is very friendly and welcoming, drop in and have chat when you are passing.

We give as much support as possible to the children, their families at home and also the Host Families who take the children into their homes for the whole month, the donations and support we receive from our local community form a great part of this support. Yes, the main purpose of the children's visit is for Health Recuperation but how brilliant is

it that we can also give them memories to take home that will last them a lifetime!

We are always happy to continue to receive donations of clothing for the children throughout the year, any age is appreciated as we provide clothing to the children when they come here and also to their siblings at home plus other children who, for various reasons, are unable to be included in the program who we will visit in Belarus later this year.

On August 26th I will travel with 18 people, 13 of whom are from Mid Suffolk, on a good will mission to Belarus. This will be their first time visiting Belarus and will give them the opportunity to visit the children they have hosted over the past few years. The trip will include a visit to the Children's Cancer Hospital in Minsk, several Social Shelters (cross between an Orphanage and a Foster Home) and we will also visit a local school and take part in the "First Bell" ceremony which celebrate the beginning of the new school year.

I am sure there will be much to report on our return!
